

Dress Code

To create a positive learning environment and help every dancer succeed, students are expected to arrive at each class dressed appropriately with hair secured neatly before class begins. Proper dance attire allows instructors to see body alignment, improves safety, and helps dancers feel confident and prepared.

General Guidelines

- Dancewear should be appropriate for the style, fitted, and allow for full range of movement.
- Hair must be secured away from the face in a bun or ponytail, appropriate for the class.
- Jewelry should be kept to a minimum. Large jewelry should not be worn during class.
- Dance shoes should be clean and worn only inside the studio.
- Label all shoes and personal belongings with the dancer's name. Lost and found is located in the dressing room. Legacy Academy of Dance is not responsible for lost items.

Combo, Littles & Preschool Classes

- Dance attire: leotard, dance dress, shorts/leggings and shirt, anything littles can move in!
- Ballet shoes for ballet/jazz
- Tap shoes for combo classes
- Hair secured away from the face

Ballet

- Solid-colored leotard
- Pink tights
- ballet shoes (canvas or leather)
- Hair neatly pulled back
- Shorts or skirts over leotard are permitted
- Ballet stretch and strength class can wear leggings or bike shorts over leotard instead of tights

Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary, Turns & Leaps, Technique, Pom:

- Leotard or fitted dance top/bra
- Leggings or shorts
- Appropriate footwear for the style (pirouettes or jazz shoes)
- Hair neatly back

Hip Hop & Mini Cheer/Pom

- Comfortable athletic clothing that allows movement (clean athletic pants, shorts, or leggings with a fitted T-shirt or tank)
- Clean, non-marking sneakers worn only inside the studio
- Hair secured

Our Studio Space:

Water bottles are encouraged. We ask that you make sure the lid is secure before entering the studio.

Our studio staff works very hard to maintain a clean environment for our students and families. Please help us maintain a clean environment by picking up after yourselves and your children. Students, you are free to use the breakroom and dressing room between classes but you must pick up your trash and clean up any food items, spills, crumbs, etc.! Failure to clean up after yourself multiple times will result in a loss of privilege of using the space.
